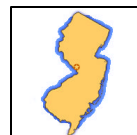
Hawaii Senate Bill No. 2897

SUMMARY: Allows a lease of all or part of a state boating facility to be disposed of by public auction; requires all revenues from the lease of facilities to be deposited into the boating special fund; allows the negotiation of the disposition of public lands for marina and yacht club purposes, including small boat harbors; requires disposition to be made to qualified marina management firms; allows moorage for commercial vessels in the Ala Wai and Keehi boat harbors.
